



Accessibility Information for Spokane Valley United Methodist Church

Spokane Valley UMC is a Gold Badge Accessible Facility and is excited to welcome the PNW Annual Conference session in June! They have provided us with some helpful information to prepare for our time of holy conferencing.

Parking: Those who would benefit from an automatic ADA entrance are encouraged to park in our South parking lot. For those who do not require access to an ADA entrance, they are encouraged to park in the east or west lots of the church, or in the city-provided parking lot on the west side of the church, adjacent to the park. There is also street parking available on Main St. (north side)

Exterior Entrances: In addition to the South Parking Lot ADA entrance, the main entrance on N. Raymond Rd. has ramp access, and there will be volunteers present to open doors and offer a warm welcome. The Sanctuary entrance on Main. St. (north side) is also accessible via a ramp, with volunteers present to open doors. Please note that these doors will be locked when plenary is in session.

Interior Accessibility: The church facility features an elevator and ADA restrooms on the main floor right outside the Sanctuary. Plenary will be held in the Sanctuary, and there are ADA-designated seating areas midway in the nave as well as a ramp for access to the Chancel. We anticipate installing a T-Coil Hearing Assist system by the time we gather, and an over-the-ear hearing assistive system is also available.
