International Offering - Service of the Ordering of Ministry

The [Endowment for Theological Education in the Central Conferences](#) addresses a stark reality: while 71% of U.S. United Methodist clergy hold graduate theological degrees, fewer than 5% of clergy in Africa, Europe, and the Philippines do.

Established by the Council of Bishops, the endowment provides sustainable, permanent funding for scholarships, contextual curriculum development, multilingual resources, and Wesleyan faculty support — free from the uncertainty of General Conference budget cycles.

With a goal of raising \$25 million, the fund aims to equip 500 additional graduates each year to serve growing United Methodist communities around the world.
